Welcome back to school everyone and to the first day of spring. Also, a warm KTS welcome to Anna, who started today in Room 11.

Level 2 at School

Health and safety protocols are being followed in classrooms including regular hand sanitisation, wiping down of devices and named pencils and pens in the junior school.

Drop offs are working well, thank you for supporting this additional opportunity for your children to be independent as you avoid coming onto the school grounds. Please remember the junior gate is open for drop off until 8.50am.

Pick up: please arrange a meeting point with your child (Years 2–8) so that they know which gate to meet you at. Junior students (Years 0–1) will be brought to the junior gate for pick up. Year 2–8 students are released at 3.00pm to meet parents at their agreed spot.

If parents do have to come on site, please scan the COVID-19 QR code and collect a red dot or sign in the office and pick up a lanyard. We also encourage adults to wear a mask, just as we are doing with staff who are on entry point duty.

A few reminders as we head into spring weather. The parking area next to the junior area of the school is not for our use – it is for University of Auckland staff and the pre-school community.

Also, the drop-off zone at the main entrance to the school is working really efficiently. If you are dropping your children off, please use it. Ballot for Out-of-Zone Enrolments for 2021

Kohia Terrace School will be holding a Ballot on Wednesday 21st October 2020 for out-of-zone enrolments.

The Board has determined that places are likely to be available for out-of-zone students in the following year levels:

Priority 2-6

Year 0 (children who will turn 5 on or after 1 June 2021)

Year 1

Year 2

The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

The closing date for out-of-zone applications will be Wednesday 14th October 2020.

Parents of students who live within the home zone should also enrol by this date to assist the school to plan appropriately for next year.
