#### Hero app

Thanks to people who have let us know about a problem opening our newsletter (or other pdfs) through the phone app. We are working this through with Linc-Ed; as a first step they suggest ensuring that all updates have been uploaded. We are trying to ascertain if it is a problem just with our school or more widespread which will help focus the fix required. In the meantime, please access HERO via your computer.

#### **Financial Statements**

Now we have HERO well underway at school, a request for payment will come out today to your email address. Information about school payments, and the breakdown of the activity costs, can be found on the <u>school website</u>. Following MInistry of Education guidelines, we are no longer offering a first-term reduction in our desired parent donation, so the \$480 per student is reflected in the statement being sent. If you have three children at the school, the amount for the third child is halved, and for those with four children, there is no cost for the fourth. These guidelines can also be found on the webpage linked above. We are just in the process of confirming the Year 5 and Year 6 camp costs.

Some of you may have seen in the media the payments from the Ministry of Education of \$150 per student, to replace all requests to parents for donations. This was offered to decile 1 - 7 schools only, we are decile 9.

We thank you in advance for your support of the school and very much appreciate those who pay the donation.

# Spotlight on Sport

## FlippaBall for Years 3 – 6

Is your child interested in playing in the KTS Year 3/4 or Year 5/6 FlippaBall team? KTS had two strong FlippaBall teams last year and it would be great to see this sport grow!

What to know:

- Children do have to be confident in water – and happy not to wear goggles – but at this early stage they do not have to be competent swimmers.

- They are touching the ground at all times, with the games being played in water depths of 100–120cm.
- The games are played locally at either the St Cuthberts or Dio school pools.
- Practices are held on a Wednesday afternoon, 3:45-4:30pm at the Auckland Grammar pool.

- Games last around 20 mins and are usually held early Sunday afternoon (the times have not yet been confirmed).
