We wish the students who are taking part in the school cross country all the best for their run on Thursday at Melville Park.






#### **Learning Posts**

#### Drop off and pick up

A reminder that classrooms open at **8:30am** and that students should be at school by 8:45am so they have the time to set up for their school day. We do not have staff on duty after school as they are often engaged in professional learning or are preparing for the next day's programme.
