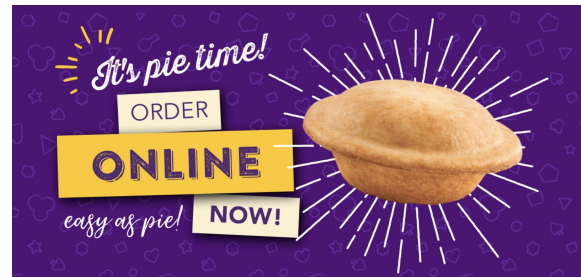
Jesters Pie Day

Fancy a day off from making school lunch? Support the PTA and order a delicious pie.

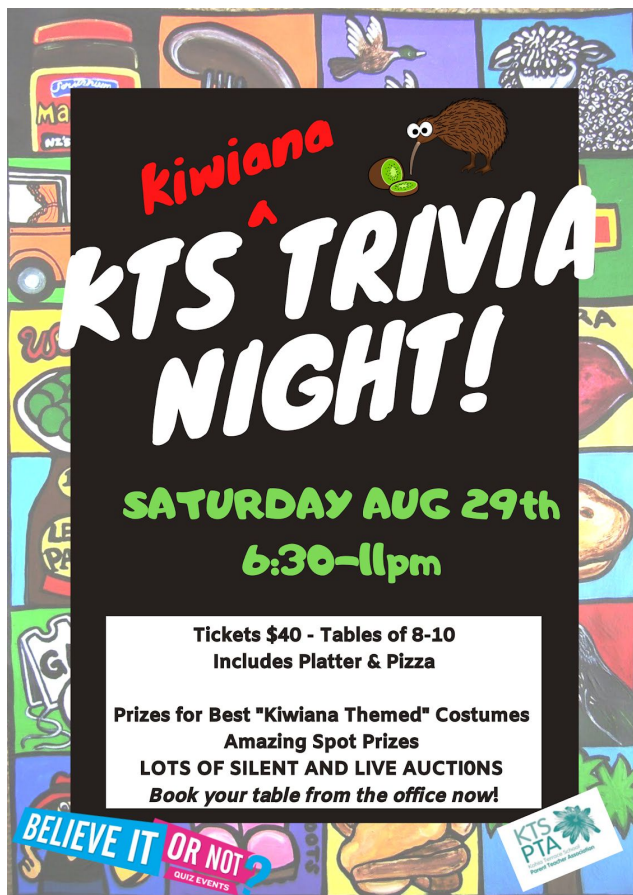
Go on to the school Kindo page and select from the various options and on **Thursday 6 August** your child will get their hot, tasty pie delivered to their classroom in time for lunch.
