Mālō e lelei - this week is Tongan Language Week.

Currently, there are more Tongan people born in New Zealand than there are in Tonga, giving lea faka-Tonga (the Tonga language) and anga faka-Tonga (Tonga culture) a special place here in Aotearoa.

Tonga Language Week / Uike Kātoanga'i 'o e lea faka-Tonga gives students of all ethnicities the chance to learn some basic lea faka-Tonga, and gives students who speak lea faka-Tonga the chance to be experts in the classroom.

Out-of zone ballot

Kohia Terrace School will be holding a Ballot on Wednesday 21st October 2020 for out-of-zone enrolments. The Board has determined that places are likely to be available for out-of-zone students for Priority 2–6 in the following year levels: **Year 0** (children who will turn 5 on or after 1 June 2021); **Year 1** and **Year 2**.

The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school's home zone.

The closing date for out-of-zone applications will be Wednesday 14th October 2020.

Parents of students who live within the home zone should also enrol by this date to assist the school to plan appropriately for next year.
