### Parent to-do list

- ★ Complete the quick survey if you haven't yet: Survey Link
- ★ Students who walk home will be released to collect younger siblings (if required) and will leave school at 2.50pm.
- ★ If you are coming to collect your children, please DO NOT enter the school <u>unless absolutely</u> <u>necessary</u>. Please arrange a meeting place so we do not have a crowd at the school gate. Road patrols will operate on both crossings so students could cross and meet you at one of the following suggested locations:
  - Woodhall Road
  - Ranfurly Road
  - St Andrews Road
  - Gillies Ave
  - Kimberley Road
  - Epsom Ave
- ★ Please remember your own physical distancing.
- ★ Year 1 and 2 students, who do not have older brothers or sisters at the school can be collected at 2.45pm from the classroom (entry to the school via the junior gate, which will be unlocked at this time). NB: On Monday 18th May, you can also bring your child to their classroom via the junior gate if you really need to. NB: this will be unlocked only for the first day back.
- ★ Classrooms open at 8.30am.
- ★ School grounds will be closed at 3.15pm.
- ★ Please do not send your child to school if they are at all unwell (runny nose, coughing etc.)
- ★ Any school device that was borrowed from the school needs to be returned to your child's classroom on Monday please.

# **Contact Tracing**

- ★ PLEASE only come into the school if you really need to.
- ★ All parents, if they do enter the school grounds, MUST be registered to do so.
- ★ 8.30 8.50 am, and 2.40 3.10pm, entry points will be the bottom field gate and the main entrance on Kohia Terrace (Alison, Becca, Catherine and Fe have master rolls to check people in).
- ★ Parents will be given a red dot to wear whilst on site (this shows you are checked in).
- ★ Between 8.50am and 2.40pm, parents report to the school office to sign in. You will be given a lanyard to wear. Only 3 people in the office at any one time please.
- ★ Parents are **NOT** to enter the classrooms.

#### **Students will be**

- ★ Hand sanitising every time they enter a room
- ★ Cleansing hands before eating
- ★ Eating lunch in their classrooms each day
- ★ Using their own pencil or pen (these will be named)
- ★ Being mindful of safe breath zone at all times

#### We will be

- ★ Enjoying having time with our classes
- ★ Making our students feel safe and welcome
- ★ Going through healthy practices each day
- ★ Checking that there is no one at school who is unwell
- ★ Washing / sanitising all hands before eating and when entering the classroom each time
- ★ Opening the doors for whole class entry and exit times
- ★ Cleaning the toilets twice a day
- ★ Cleaning tables twice day
- ★ Wiping down devices each day
- ★ Providing a learning overview for a week for learning at home if you choose not to send your children back
- ★ Continuing distance learning for those who have medical reasons not to be attending school

#### **Students will need to bring**

- ★ A named drink bottle
- ★ For Year 4 8 students, they can bring in their own device for use in the classroom if they wish (please email Florin@kts.school.nz to be sent the form for this).
