It is good to be back underway again this week. Teachers and students are managing smooth transitions between distance and classroom learning, it is becoming the new normal. Thank you for supporting your children by juggling Zoom meetings and talking through learning tasks; we know that it can be a challenge. If you still have any devices that were borrowed for distance learning please return them as soon as possible as they are used for learning on a daily basis.
