


## Katie Williams - Room 13

# Life in Year 5

### **Home Learning**

Home learning will be sent home once a fortnight on a Monday, starting in Week 3. This includes a range of activities and tasks for your child to complete which will reflect their class learning, as well as exploring new areas of learning.

It is important that your child is reading, working on spelling words and on Mathletics most nights.



### **Cyber Safety**

All parents and students are required to sign an Internet Safety agreement concerning the operation and use of the Internet and ICT equipment in the school. Students reviewed this agreement in class at the beginning of the year.

In Year 5 ICT will be used often to communicate, share and explore new learning.



### **Routines and Learning**

There are hooks outside the classroom where school bags can be hung. Classrooms will be open for children from 8:30am for students to get ready for the school day and return any notices if needed.

The children may choose a quiet activity inside or play outside until the second bell at 8:50am.

Morning tea break runs from 10:30am to 11am and lunch from 12:40pm to 1:30pm. A variety o ordered lunches are available through the Ezi-lunch online booking system located on the KTS website. School finishes at 3pm after which the children are free to safely make their way home.





### **Behaviour**

Please refer to the Kohia Terrace School expectations of behaviour, known as the Kohia Code. Room 12 and 13 have also developed a few chosen rules, reflective of the school expectations of behaviour, which we think are necessary for creating a safe, happy environment that encourages and supports learning.

### Library

Both classes have their library session on Tuesday afternoons. During this time, children are encouraged to select two books and have these issued under their name. Books are issued for a period of two weeks.

In Year 5, we are recommending that all students issue one book to read at school during SSR time and one to read at home. The library is also open during lunchtimes.

We also encourage all children to start or continue with the library Literacy Awards. Jane our librarian has an incredible programme running.







### **Lost Property**

There is a school lost property box located outside Room 9 and a box outside Room 3. These are the first places we recommend to look for something if it is lost.

However, **please** ensure that all items of clothing are named, including hats and lunch boxes.
