# **Home Learning**

Home learning will be sent home once a fortnight on a Monday. This includes a range of activities and tasks for your child to complete that reflect their class learning. These will include online and offline tasks. It is important that your child is reading, working on spelling words and practising their basic facts every night. Home learning is encouraged.



# **Cyber Safety**

All parents and students are required to sign an Internet Safety agreement concerning the operation and use of the Internet and ICT equipment in the school. Students reviewed this agreement in class at the beginning of the year.

In Year 6 ICT will be used often to communicate, share and explore new learning.

# **Routines and Learning**



There are hooks outside the classroom where school bags can be hung. Classrooms will be open for children from 8.30am for students to get ready for the school day and return any notices. The children may choose a quiet activity inside or play outside until the second bell at 8.50am. Morning tea break runs from 10.30 – 11am and lunch 12.40 – 1.30. A variety of ordered lunches are available through the Ezi- lunch online booking system located on the KTS website. School finishes at 3pm after which the children are free to safely make their way home.

# **Sick Children**

If your child is unwell, we would really appreciate you keeping them home so that they can get well quickly. This is especially important given the ongoing global pandemic. Please remember to phone the office to leave a message informing us that they are sick.

If your child is clearly unwell at school, we will send them to the sick bay and the office staff will contact you to collect them.



### Library and PE times

Both classes have their library session Thursday morning. During this time children are allowed to select two books and have these issued in their name; these are issued for a period of two weeks. In Year 6 we are recommending students issue one book to read at school during daily SSR time and one to read at home. The library is also home during lunchtimes.

Our Year 6 PE skills sessions are on Thursdays with us joining Year 5 for a range of seasonally appropriate sports on Friday afternoons.
