Scenario 1: **Reliever** in class

Scenario 2: **Cover team** in class

Scenario 3: **Hybrid learning (whole year group)**
 Classes merge within year groups
 On-site teacher supervises and teaches with additional support
 Off-site teacher teaches whole class/groups and any distance learners via zoom
 Google classroom (yr 2-8) in action for on-site and off-site learning

Both year group teachers absent

one sick
one isolating

Scenario 4: **Distance learning with on-site support**
 All students follow online learning programme; some volunteer to stay at home **
 Vulnerable learners will be supported on-site ***devices supplied if needed*
 Isolating teacher runs learning programme from home, supported by onsite staff

both sick with Covid

Scenario 5: **Back to basics distance learning** with additional tasks on Google Classroom if possible..
 Staff are Covid positive - all students will be isolating as close contacts

both sick not Covid

Scenario 1 and 2 - students will be onsite with relief or internal teaching staff

Multiple teachers absent

isolating/sick

Scenario 6: **Back to basics distance learning** or scenario 4 if possible
 Students volunteer to learn from home (reducing on-site numbers)
 Relievers and other on-site staff supervise at school,
 Vulnerable learners are supported on site
 Isolating teachers provide additional material and support from home

Multiple teachers absent including senior leaders and/or key office staff

Scenario 7: **Whole school distance learning - BOT decision**
 BOT moves whole school to distance learning until staffing levels are adequate
 If classroom teacher is sick: **scenario 6**,
Provision for vulnerable students or for essential workers' children will be made
