Stretch out the idea to get kids planting and growing - competitions for biggest pumpkin/sunflower etc. Lisa is awaiting more info mid-July from Kings.

- Art Calendars (as usual) combined with art mugs
- International Night make a bit bigger, and make fundraising a focus.

Intermediate Market day was very successful, we could recreate that and incorporate it into the International Night. Students plan stalls and make items to sell, e.g. bath bombs, Christmas decorations etc.

Families buy tokens in advance, to save individual stalls handling money.

Food stalls - Alison to look at restrictions around food prep. People are hesitant around food sharing at the moment
