Life in Year 4

Home Learning

Home learning will be sent home once a fortnight on a Monday. This includes a range of activities and tasks for your child to complete that reflect their class learning. These will include online and offline tasks. It is important that your child reads and practises basic facts every night. Home learning is encouraged in Year 4. The home learning grid will also be added to our Google Classrooms each fortnight.



Routines and Learning



There are hooks outside the classroom where school bags can be hung. Classrooms will be open for children from 8.30am for students to get ready for the school day and return any notices.

Cyber Safety

All parents and students are required to sign an Internet Safety agreement concerning the operation and use of the Internet and ICT equipment in the school.

Students have access to SmartLab to support their learning. Hero will continue to be used to share evidence of learning and Google Classroom for learning tasks.

Inappropriate use of computers (websites, messaging, Google Classroom) at school is taken very seriously and will result in a conversation with our Principal Alison, and the potential loss of usage for an appropriate period of time.



Sick Children

If your child is unwell, we would really appreciate you keeping them home so that they can get well quickly. Please remember to phone or email the office to leave a message informing us that they are sick, or log the absence via Hero.

If your child is clearly unwell at school, we will send them to the sick bay and the office staff will contact you to collect them.



Library, Science, PE, Drama and Music

Both classes have their library session on a Wednesday. During this time children are allowed to select two books and have these issued in their name; these are issued for two weeks. In Year 4 we are recommending students issue one book to read at school and one to read at home. The library is also open during lunchtimes.

Our PE skills sessions are on Mondays, and we will practise a range of seasonally appropriate sports on Thursdays with the other Harakeke classes.

Music and drama lessons are on a Tuesday morning, and Science lessons are with Whaea Nicola every second Thursday.
