# Behaviour

# Home Learning

Home learning will be sent home once a fortnight on an even week. This includes a range of activities and tasks for your child to complete that reflect their class learning as well as explore new areas of learning. A digital copy of this sheet is also uploaded onto our Year 5 Google Classroom for access in case they cannot find their physical copy that is glued in their books.

It is important that your child is reading, working on the code activities and practising their basic facts every night.



# Routines

There are hooks outside the classroom where school bags can be hung. Classrooms will be open for children from 8.30am for students to get ready for the school day and return any notices.

The children may choose a quiet activity inside or play outside until the second bell at 8.50am.

Morning tea break runs from 10.30 – 11am and lunch 12.40 – 1.30. School finishes at 3pm after which the children are free to safely make their way home.

# ICT



All parents and students are required to sign an Internet Safety agreement concerning the operation and use of the Internet and ICT equipment in the school.

Students have access to Oxford Math and SmartLabs to support their learning. Hero will continue to be used to share evidence of learning and Google Classroom for learning tasks.

Inappropriate use of computers (websites, messaging, Google classroom) at school is taken very seriously and will result in a conversation with our Principal Alison, and potential loss of usage for an appropriate period of time.



# Library and PE

Both classes have their library session on Mondays. During this time children are allowed to select two books and have these issued in their name; these are issued for a period of two weeks.

In Year 5, we are recommending students issue two books - one book to read at school during SSR time and one to read at home. The library is also open during lunchtimes.

Our Year 5 PE skills sessions will be timetabled differently for each class. We will run a combined Years 4, 5 and 6 session once a week. We also do a range of fitness activities most days to keep students moving and to work on fine motor skills.
