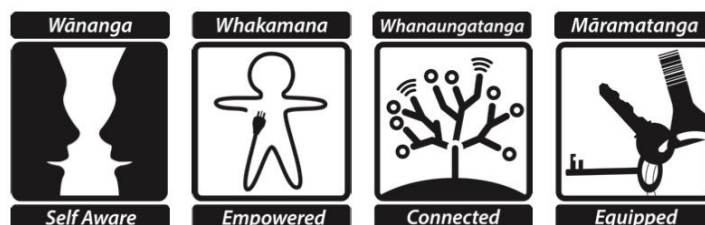

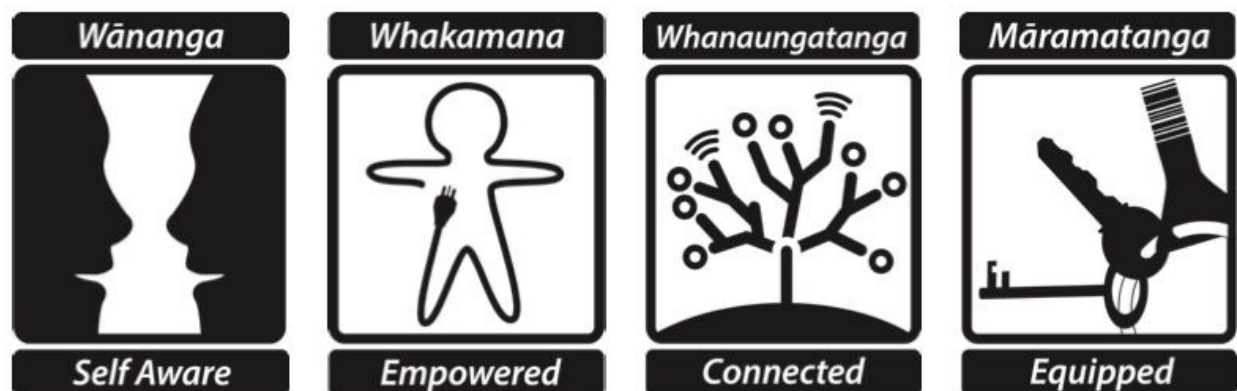

To be a community that inspires a world of possibilities by being...

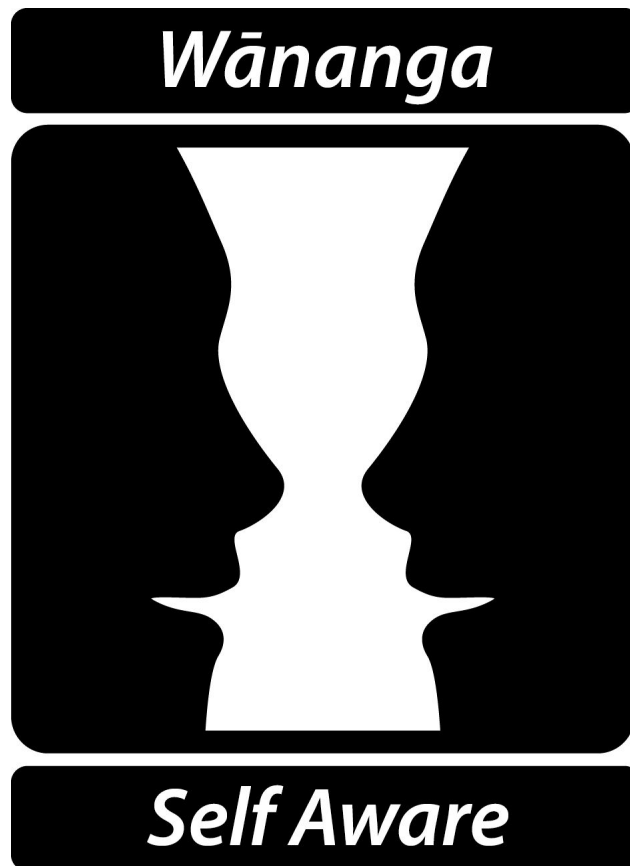


We believe that by displaying these attributes our students, staff and parents can create a partnership to support our students' learning and achievement.

As a KTS Parent, I am

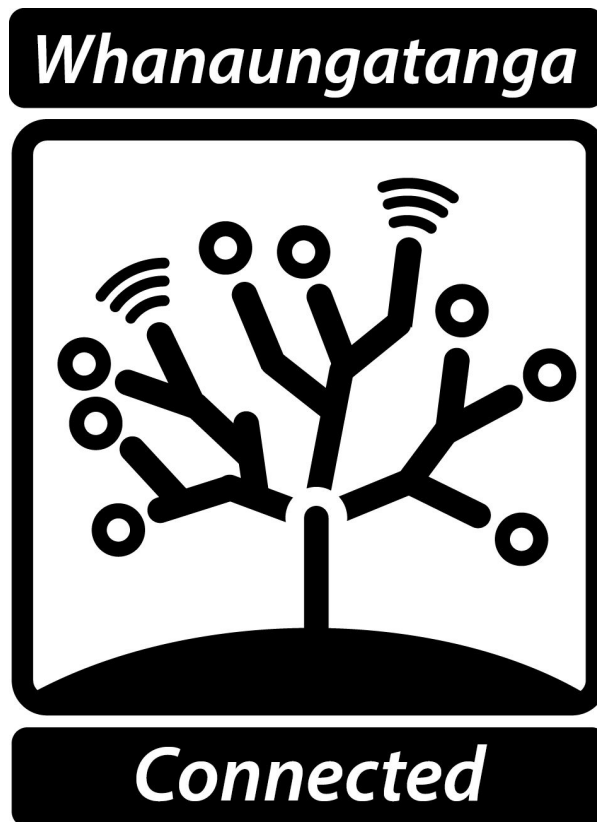


when I

- ❖ attend my child's Three Way Learning Conferences (3WLC)
  - **so that** a learning-focused relationship is established

- ❖ read the weekly newsletter
