



We invite you to join with us and your children so that as life-long learners we are all developing personally and professionally.


Kohia te wānanga e tū ki te ao mārama Gather the knowledge of the ancestors and stand to face the world



- know that I have valuable knowledge about my child (social, academic, emotional)
 - so that it can be shared with teachers and be used in planning the child's learning programme
- take part in open and honest conversations with teachers
 - > so that useful information is shared about my child
- know it is ok to ask questions about my child's learning
 - > so that I can find out how to better support my child's learning at home
- share my skills or contacts with school
 - so that these can be used to support my child's learning programme or the school's development
- ask for a translator when needed
 - > so that I can fully participate in learning conversations with teachers



- attend parent information meetings
 - > so that I learn about school initiatives
- read supporting information about my child's learning
 - > so that I understand how to talk with my child about their school work
- read my child's school reports with them
 - so that my child's progress and achievement can be discussed and celebrated
- know about my child's learning pathways
 - so that I can ask appropriate questions and make constructive comments about my child's learning
- use resources on the school website
 - so that I can support my child's learning at home
- contribute to goal-setting for my child's learning
 - so that I am actively involved in the collaborative partnership between school and home



- attend my child's Three Way Learning Conferences (3WLC)
 - > so that a learning-focused relationship is established
- know that my child has an active role in the home-school partnership
 - so that they are being encouraged to take greater responsibility for their own learning
- meet other parents at KTS
 - > so that I am contributing to a positive sense of community
- read the weekly newsletter
 - > so that I am well-informed about school news and events
- read school-link emails
 - > **so that** I am aware of important updates
- read teacher's emails and class notices
 - > so that timely information is received and can be clarified if needed
- support KTS by volunteering my time (class helper, road patrol, sport)
 - so that teachers' focus is on learning and teaching
- am encouraged to participate in school events
 - > so that a sense of community is fostered



- find out how to engage in my child's learning
 - > so that I have a positive impact on my child's learning outcomes
- complete parent surveys
