



Parent Supporter Code of Conduct

- Be proud and pleased that my child is participating
- Provide my child with opportunities – not forcing them into sports I think they should do
- Support their sporting choices
- Provide encouragement
- Praise effort **and** achievement
- Use positive criticism
- Demonstrate positive participation as a parent – get involved!
- Support the coach, manager and volunteers
- Respect the coaches role
- Acknowledge the efforts of other children and volunteers
- Celebrate “milestones” with my child (individual goals / improvement)
- Support the whole team, not just my own child
- Provide recognition and acknowledgement to other children where appropriate
- Cheer rather than lecture / demand
- Support rather than direct / coach
- Raise any issues with coaching or management on a one-to-one basis in an appropriate and timely manner, through the right process
- Teach my child to win with pride and loose with dignity
- Be aware of and remind our child that an individual’s poor behaviour will have a direct reflection upon the school, and not just the individual
- Be a positive role model for my child, their team and their school
